ROUND ONE

Disappointing entry of three teams. The easiest thing to do to make sure everyone gets a match in the first round is play all the teams and then take the three winners plus the best loser through to the semi finals. By best loser I mean the team who finish closest, in other words, lose by the least -- to do that, or course, it means playing all matches to a conclusion which means playing all 16 games. However, it is not often that a match finishes before that anyway.

All matches to be played by Friday 22 February 2019 which gives plenty of weeks to play including some when there are no league matches. I have included the league cup week to give a little more leeway with so few entries, so plenty of time -- but don't leave it to the last minute.

The semi finals will be played, if possible, before the end of the season so that the final can be arranged just after the league season ends.

Please note that the organisers reserve the right to adjust the handicaps (both up and down) should any player show different to normal results between now and the semi finals.

Diff = Difference between the calculations of one team and the other.

H'cap = Start that is received by the team with the HIGHER number.

IN THE CASE OF A TIED MATCH

If BOTH teams agree they can replay the match at the other venue if applicable, provided it can be played before the closing date for the round.

However, this is not always convenient.
