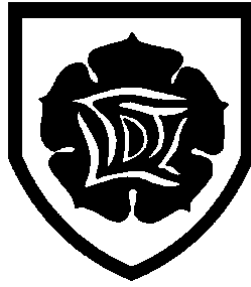

Dear Club Secretary/Contact

I am writing, as promised, to inform you of any rule change proposals for the 2026 Annual General Meeting (**to be held at Goons/Braunstone Victoria WMC on Wednesday 27 May starting at 7.0pm and followed by the Presentation Evening at 8.0/8.15pm**).

One such proposal has been received from the membership- please see below (page 2). There are none from the Committee.

A copy of the minutes of the 2025 AGM is attached.

The business to be transacted (a full agenda will be provided on the night) will also include:

- Reports from officers
- Approval of the Accounts
- Setting of fees for 2026/27
- Election of officers

May I remind you that, in accordance with League Rule 3f, any club failing to send a representative will be fined £6, and that no person may represent more than one club.

A club is entitled to one vote for each of its teams, but under League Rule 3d no person may exercise more than one vote.

You have already been sent the registration form for next season; a reminder that this should be returned by 1 June (together with £10 deposit per team); the remaining forms will be distributed at the AGM.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO LEAGUE RULE 21 (from John Bowness/Knighton Park TTC).

The four bullet points remain the same. Change the existing last paragraph to:

Four points shall be awarded for wins of 10-0, 9-1 and 8-2.

Three points shall be awarded for wins of 7-3 and 6-4.

Two points shall be awarded for a 5-5 draw.

One point shall be awarded for a 3-7 and 4-6 defeat.

No points for a defeat of 2-8 or higher.

Thus each match will be decided out of four points.

Add final paragraph (This is because provision is not there currently).

Should both teams have two players this means that only nine sets can be counted, ie:

Four singles, One doubles and Four defaults. Points awarded in this case are:

9-0, 8-1 and 7-2 wins: Four points.

6-3 and 5-4 wins: Three points.

3-6 and 4-5 defeats: One point.

2-7, 1-8 and 0-9 defeats: No points.
